## Elecnor increases its investment in safety to 62.6 million and achieves its second-best ever figure for accident prevention

- ▶ Workplace safety is a priority for the Group and is integrated across all its operations, with the aim of ensuring the protection of everyone involved in its projects and services.
- ▶ This progress in prevention is underpinned by a strategy based on innovation, digitalisation and the commitment of its professionals, alongside continuous training and the improvement of working conditions.

The Elecnor Group has invested over **€62.6 million** in 2025 in occupational risk prevention measures, an **increase of more than 36%** compared to the **€46 million** allocated in 2024. Occupational safety is one of the Group's fundamental pillars and reflects its commitment to protecting its workers and everyone involved in its projects and services. During Occupational Health and Safety Month, the company reinforces its **goal of achieving 'zero accidents'**, relying on a strategy of continuous improvement with an increase in resources year on year.

This investment effort has enabled the company **to reduce the number of workplace accidents**, achieving a frequency rate – which measures the number of accidents per million hours worked – of 1.9, the second-best figure in its history.

These results have been made possible by a commitment to **innovation** as a cross-cutting element of the Group's Health and Safety strategy. The integration of technologies such as **digital transformation, Artificial Intelligence, Big Data and Virtual Reality** enables not only the optimisation of processes, but also the anticipation of risks, improved decision-making and enhanced worker preparedness in increasingly demanding environments.

At the same time, the worker's commitment has established itself as one of the key pillars of the preventive model. Throughout 2025, the Group's professionals have contributed more than **1,000 ideas for improvement**, highlighting their knowledge of the real risks in the workplace. Furthermore, Elecnor has strengthened its resources, building a team of **600 health and safety technicians and 90 healthcare professionals**, with a presence in more than 40 countries.

"Safety is a non-negotiable value: it cannot be compromised or downplayed. The judgement of a trained individual is irreplaceable. That is why, in 2026, we launched the 'Improvement in Prevention' project, which will run until 2027 to strengthen our model and create safer working environments," says Alberto García de los Ángeles, CEO of the Elecnor Group.

### Training and monitoring of working conditions

As a key component of this model, the company has delivered an extensive training programme, totalling over **958,000 hours of health and safety training**, reaching **200,000 more participants** than last year, and comprising nearly **887,000 training sessions for employees**. In addition, there have been over **160,000 hours** of training in technological areas, aimed at strengthening safety in increasingly complex

work environments. Furthermore, **awareness-raising** continues to gain momentum through initiatives such as "Control your risks", which attracted **2,500 participants**, and the holding of over **18,900 on-site meetings** to reinforce a culture of prevention throughout the organisation.

The strengthening of mechanisms **to monitor working conditions** has also been key, with over **366,000 major risk permits (PRPs)**, **113,000 safety inspections**, **529 internal audits** and more than **102,000 corrective measures implemented**, thereby reinforcing supervision and continuous improvement mechanisms across all operations.

## Commitment to Occupational Health and Safety

As part of **World Day for Safety and Health at Work**, celebrated on 28 April, Ecnor launched various internal awareness-raising and outreach initiatives aimed at strengthening the culture of prevention throughout the organisation. Among these actions, a highlight was **the internal event** at which progress on prevention was presented as part of the new Health and Safety campaign, focusing on the importance of decision-making in high-risk environments. Under the slogan **"Your decision could cost lives. Think about it before making it"**, the initiative highlights invisible risks and the shared responsibility across the entire chain of command.
