30.5 million euros

Elecnor acquires the 30% holding in the wind power company Enerfín Enervento Exterior owned by NCG Banco

<u>Madrid, 22 May 2012</u>. Elecnor and NCG Banco have reached an agreement so that the former can acquire the 30% holding in the company Enerfín Enervento Exterior owned by NCG Banco for 30.5 million euros.

Enerfín Enervento Exterior is also the majority shareholder in **Ventos do Sul Energía**, the Brazilian company that owns the Osorio, Dos Indios and Sangradouro wind farms, which has been in operation since the end of 2006 in the state of Río Grande do Sul.

With this acquisition, **Elecnor** is strengthening its interest in the Brazilian wind power market, where it currently has more than 428 MW in operation, under construction or which have been granted and are being developed, making the company one of the sector leaders in Brazil.
